## TAKE THE HYDRANT (DRY)

COMPETENCY NUMBER:

INDIVIDUAL PERFORMANCE STANDARD:

OBJECTIVE: Firefighter will properly remove hose, necessary appliances, and tools from the apparatus and secure the 5" supply line to a hydrant (dry) using all safety precautions and while wearing full protective clothing and SCBA. AO will lay-in 100'.

TIME STANDARD: 1.0 minute

PROCEDURE		YES	NO
1.	Repeat order. "TAKE THE HYDRANT- DRY."		
2.	<b>Remove hydrant board (or hydrant wrench and proper hydrant adapters, if no hydrant board) and pull supply line from the rear of apparatus.</b>		
3.	<b>Secure 5" supply line to hydrant with webbing by making a girth hitch around hose and dropping loop over hydrant. (DON'T WRAP)</b>		
4.	Set the webbing by pulling on the hose until the webbing tightens and the hose doesn't slip.		
5.	Return to and remount engine. (Time stops)
